Drinking Water Project - Approval

System Improvements Project

\$940,210

Under this proposed project, approximately 1.0 acre of land will be purchased, and a new office building and garage will be constructed. Repairs will be made to the existing McKee Storage Tank and the access road to the tank. Approximately 5,300 LF of 6" water main to Oldham Tank will be replaced, along with 8 meter settings, and a new flush hydrant will be installed. An approximate 100 LF directional drill across a creek will be necessary. Approximately 700 LF of creek crossings will be replaced. 6 new auto flush units will be installed. Kiddville Road PRV will be rebuilt. 400 new radio read meters will be purchased to replace aging radio read meters throughout the system. A new Chlorine Booster Station will be installed. 2 fire hydrants will be replaced. 10 new flush hydrants will be installed. 10 new gate valves will be installed. Additionally, the items needed to connect Levee Road Water and Jeffersonville Water will be purchased and installed, including a vault, master meter, and flush hydrant.

Meter Settings Replacement Project

\$475,000

This project would identify and replace approximately 250 of the most problematic meter settings in Levee Road Water's system.

This project will construct a 300,000 gallon elevated storage tank with telemetry.

Radio Read Meter Replacement Project

\$1,700,000

This project will replace approximately 6,500 manual read meters with radio read meters.

Derrickson Lift Station Upgrade Project

\$949,000

This project would replace the existing Derrickson Lift Station and corresponding force main to address sanitary sewer overflow (SSO) events. The new lift station (approximately 700 GPM) would be designed with higher flow pumps and a larger wet well, designed to current regulations. Due to the expansion and growth in customer base in the northern part of Rowan County, approximately 11,000 LF of 10-inch force main would be installed to increase capacity within this section of the collection system.

Countywide Waterline Extensions Project

\$1,239,355 (*Change in Scope*)

This project proposes to extend waterlines to serve residents that currently do not have access to public water service. The project will serve approximately 93 unserved households and six (6) underserved households.

Meter Change-Out Project

\$200,000 (*Change in Scope*)

This project will test and replace as necessary 1,428 radio read meters currently installed throughout the distribution system.

Welch Road Project – Phase II

\$250,000 (*Change in Scope*)

This project will construct approximately 4,000 LF of 6” PVC waterline on Welch Road, 4,000 LF of 6” PVC waterline on Camargo-Levee Road to Fox Rd, and 5,280 LF of 6” PVC on Fox Rd. In addition, approximately 2,000 LF of 6” waterline will be constructed on Camargo-Levee Road to add an emergency interconnection with Montgomery County Water District #1. An emergency interconnection with Levee Road Water Association will also be added. The project will provide water service to 25 currently unserved households.

Phase III Meter Replacement Project

\$50,000 (*Previous Project Cost: \$100,000*)

This project will replace 200 manual read meters with radio read meters.

Line Checking Meter Project

\$10,500 (*Previous Project Cost: \$3,500*)

This project will purchase and install five line checking meters to allow for effective and timely leak detection within the distribution system.

Sewer Extension to Remaining Unserved in City Limits

\$200,000 (*Change in Scope; Previous Project Cost: \$100,000*)

This project proposes to connect the few remaining homes within Owingsville city limits to public sewer service extending approximately 5,250 LF of 6" PVC and 1,000 LF of 8" PVC. It is estimated that approximately 20 homes will be connected on Water Plant Road and KY 36 North.

Lift Station and Line Upgrade Project

\$464,000 (*Change in Scope*)

Upgrade of Lift Station #2, including approximately 6,600 LF of force main, and road bores.

KRS 151.607 Annual Review/Rankings

After July 1, 2001, and annually thereafter, each area development district shall review and prioritize the planning councils' plans for underserved and unserved areas within the 2020 water management area for that district.
